Punishment for sin/Precious blood shed

- Separation from God

Review the need (sin) & way (Christ's death)

- **Keep it personal**
- **Use action/promise verse, like Acts 16:31, etc**
- **Invite.** Ex: “Would you like to have Jesus as your Savior?”
- **Give direction:** “Nod yes”, “Stand by me”, “Look up” praying
- **Counsel for salvation**
