# Punishment for sin/Precious blood shed

## Let Him be your Savior. Will you?

Review the need (sin) & way (Christ's death)

- > Keep it personal
- > Use action/promise verse, like Acts 16:31, etc
- > Invite. Ex: "Would you like to have Jesus as your Savior?"
- Give direction: "Nod yes", "Stand by me", "Look up" praying
- Counsel for salvation
