## **Bedding**

- Sleeping Bag
- Note: A sleeping bag works better than bedding when campers have their planned sleep out)
- Pillow

#### Personal

- Bible, Pen, or Pencil
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste
- Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant
- Washcloth, Towel
- Sunscreen, Bug Spray
- Flashlight

## Clothing

- Clothing for warm and cool weather
- Clothing and shoes that can get wet or dirty.
- Laundry facilities are not available at camp.

#### Swim-wear

- Towel
- One-piece modest swimsuit
- Midriff-covering Tankinis are also allowed.

## Money

- Money for Camp Store
- The remainder of the Camp fee
